The historic story of St. Valentine tells of a man, a church leader, who was imprisoned for refusing to follow government policy regarding marriage. This story reminds us that the world and the Word of God are sometimes at odds with each other. This is true in today's world, too. The theme of the St. Valentine's story is the unconditional love St. Valentine had for his prison guard's blind daughter. God loves us with this same unconditional love (in the Bible it is the Greek word familiar to many of us, "agape"). This love has care as its content, a care that is based in the heart of character of the giver and not in the deserved qualities of the recipient. This love may be romantic, but its breath encompasses care for all the people in our lives.

During the Season of Lent we lift our eyes above and beyond the station of our lives to behold Jesus. He leads us to the Cross of Calvary, teaching us that agape love requires sacrificial giving. Jesus gave or sacrificed His life so that we might experience God's love.

and singing. First, at 6:30 on February 14 we will come together for Ash Wednesday, a special service of repentance and forgiveness.
